FIREFIGHTER RECRUITMENT ELIGIBILITY LIST

Application Period

December 1, 2022 to January 6, 2023

- Must be a US Citizen and possess a valid Motor Vehicle Operator's License
 - o Provide a Birth Certificate or US-INS for verification
 - Must be at least 18 years of age and not over the age of 34 to apply
- Must submit a copy of your Driver's Record
 - Obtained from the Registry of Motor Vehicles from the state that issued your Motor Vehicle Operator's License (dated no more than 90 days prior to application date)
- Must submit a copy of your Criminal History Record
 - Obtained from the Attorney General's Office in the state where you reside (dated no more than 90 days prior to application date)
- Must possess a Rhode Island Firefighter Physical Performance Assessment Certificate or Certified CPAT issued after January 1, 2022, prior to an offer of Employment (not necessary to apply)
- Must possess a High School Diploma or GED Certificate prior to an offer of Employment (not necessary to apply)
- Must possess a Rhode Island EMT License or National Registry EMT Certificate prior to an offer of Employment (not necessary to apply)

By meeting all the above requirements, you will be eligible to take the written exam.

Active Military, Veterans and City of Warwick residents with proper documentation will be awarded preference points after successfully passing the written examination

Prior to employment, candidates shall be required to pass a BCI (Bureau of Criminal Identifications/Investigations) check as well as a Firefighter Medical Examination
