## MONTGOMERY TOWNSHIP DEPARTMENT OF POLICE SERVICES POLICE OFFICER JOB DESCRIPTION

## ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Able to successfully complete a NJ PTC BCPO Course of instruction.
- <u>2.</u> Operates a motor vehicle for extended periods of time in all environmental conditions and on occasion operates the vehicle at high speeds and in congested traffic situations.
- 3. Patrols assigned area of Township and enforces state and federal laws and Township Ordinances; patrols and examines buildings and residences to detect suspicious conditions and handles situations accordingly.
- <u>4.</u> Directs traffic in congested and emergency areas; reports safety hazards; responds to scene of accidents; administers first aid, and investigates cause and files accident reports: issues citations to violators of traffic laws.
- Sesponds to the scene of crimes and accidents; searches for and preserves evidence; investigates and interviews victims, witnesses, and any potential suspects; apprehends those suspected of crimes or misdemeanors; makes oral and written reports; provides testimony in court.
- <u>6.</u> Speaks before citizens' groups and participates in various training sessions.
- 7. Must be able to qualify on the shooting range with issued firearm. Must be capable of qualifying in CPR (First Aid), PR-24 / MEB and defensive chemical weapons.
- <u>8.</u> Ability to operate a two-way radio, walkie-talkie in field situations, and to operate effectively, radar equipment, breathalyzer, etc.
- <u>9.</u> Ability to read, understand and interpret ordinances, laws, and other operating procedures and communicate orally and in writing; ability to investigate crimes and do reports.
- <u>10.</u> Ability to serve the public effectively using tact and diplomacy and remain calm in emergency situations and provide constitutional requirements.
- 11. Ability to make split-second decisions that could affect the well-being of the public, department, fellow employees, as well as the officer's safety. Ability to interface with other law enforcement personnel and safety personnel.
- 12. Some exposure to unpleasant weather conditions. Requires continuous attention to safe working and operating procedures to ensure the safety of one's self and fellow citizens.
- 13. Ability to effect forcible arrests, and defend oneself or others from attack.
- <u>14.</u> Must possess the physical strength and stamina to chase and subdue fleeing persons; to arrest them if necessary; and to bring them into custody.
- 15. Great probability of working rotating 12 Hour shifts, extended hours, emergency call out, and to testify at court on days off.
- 16. Must have the physical strength and stamina to rescue victims.
