MINIMUM ENTRY LEVEL QUALIFICATIONS

All applicants must have a High School Diploma or the equivalent.

All applicants must possess a Valid Driver's License from their state of residence.

All applicants must be a Citizen of the United States.

All applicants will be at least Twenty-One years old.

All applicants will be capable of meeting a vision standard of 20/80, correctable to 20/20.

All Applicants will have normal color vision, normal depth perception, and good hearing.

All applicants are prohibited from <u>displaying</u> tattoo's, brands, piercings, or scarifications on areas of the body not covered by the summer uniform. Any Applicant who has a tattoo not covered by the summer uniform shall be required to wear a "cover" while on duty. Tattoos on the hands, neck, and head are strictly forbidden.

All applicants will be free of any physical disability which would prevent them from performing all the essential job functions of a patrol officer.

No applicant will have any felony or misdemeanor conviction.

No applicant will have an extensive motor vehicle record which would indicate a disregard for the law.

No applicant will have been dishonorably discharged from military service or have been discharged by an employer for reasons which would cast doubt on his/her fitness to be a police officer.

No applicant will have committed any misdemeanor or felony, as defined under any state or federal law, within two years prior to application.

No applicant will have used marijuana within 12 months prior to application

No applicant will have illegally used any controlled substance other than marijuana, within 36 months prior to application

No applicant will have <u>ever</u> illegally manufactured, transported for sale, or sold a controlled substance.
