Orientation:

The North Smithfield Police Department will invite you to participate in its recruitment orientation. This will be a meet & greet of NSPD members and hearing more on the recruitment process. Your questions will be welcomed and we are happy to assist you in this process.

Written Exam:

All applicants taking the written exam shall report at check-in. Each applicant must present an active driver's license. Appropriate business attire is required. No phones, no pencils will be allowed. The testing process takes approximately 3 hours.

Physical Assessment:

Following the Written Exam, the Physical Assessment will take place that afternoon **for those passing the written exam.**

You are required to bring the Physical Fitness Medical Certificate. You can download the Physical Fitness Medical Certificate here on Police App. You will have your physician complete the certificate. Please note you will not be allowed to participate without it. Please note that the certificate needs to be less than 6 months old when participating in the Physical Assessment. This is also true if you end up testing for the academy PT.

It is recommended that you wear PT Gear- a plain white tee-shirt, a pair of dark colored shorts and sneakers (spandex and muscle shirts are not allowed). Upon arrival, you must check in with a valid driver's license.

Interviews:
