HIRING NOTICE: SLEO III

The Montville Township Police Department is seeking qualified and professional applicants for the position of Class III Special Law Enforcement Officer. This position will be responsible for safety and security duties at Montville Township Middle School. Additional responsibilities may include instructing students and staff members on safety or security related topics. The Class III Special Law Enforcement Officer is an employee of the Montville Township Police Department and is under the supervision of the Chief of Police and/or his/her designee(s). This will be a full time position, approximately 40 hours per week, with a pay rate of \$34.00 per hour. The typical work day will be from 8 am until 4 pm.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Must be a retired officer less than 65 years of age who has previously served as a duly qualified, full time law
 enforcement officer in any municipality, county, or agency of the State of New Jersey, bi-state agency, or federal
 agency, and must reside in New Jersey.
- Must be retired from that agency in good standing (necessary to have a letter of good standing issued by the agency from which the officer retired, listing the date and type of retirement. A copy will be submitted to the PTC.
- Must possess a valid New Jersey Driver's License. Must pass a psychological exam. Must pass a medical exam and have the doctor complete the Medical Certification Form (Form PTC 8A)
- Must pass a drug test pursuant to the New Jersey Attorney General's Law Enforcement Drug Testing Policy.
- Must have an updated background investigation. Officers retired for more than 3 years will be required to complete the Basic Course for Police Officer, waiver for physical conditioning and defensive tactics may be granted by the PTC.
- Possess a NJ Police Training Commission Basic Police Officer Certification, NJ State Police Academy Certification, or other proof of basic police training approved by the Police Training Commission.
