The Boonton Township Police Department is actively seeking professional, qualified applicants for the position of Police Officer who possess the department's core values of honesty, integrity, fairness, compassion, and respect. Police Officers in Boonton Township are entitled to a competitive starting salary, health benefits, and enrollment into the PFRS, as well as an array of other benefits including a tuition reimbursement program aimed at the professional development of our employees.

**Minimum Qualifications:**

- The applicant must obtain a Police Training Certificate issued by the New Jersey Police Training Commission (full time regular police officer) or be currently enrolled in the State of New Jersey Police Academy as an alternate route certification candidate, or have successfully graduated from the New Jersey Police Academy Alternate Route Training Program.
- Applicant must not be less than 18 years of age, nor more than 35 years of age at the time of appointment (however, age restrictions shall not conflict with the current state and federal law).
- Shall be a high school graduate, and have earned at least 60 college credits from an accredited college or university **or** have completed (4) years active military service concluding with an honorable discharge (high school graduate also applies to military eligibility);
- Of good moral character and free from conviction of any crime constituting an indictable offense or any crime or offense involving moral turpitude;
- A citizen of the United States and a resident of the State of New Jersey for at least (6) months prior to the date of appointment;
- Able to read, write and speak the English language well and intelligently;
- The holder of a valid New Jersey driver's license;
