Applicants must:

- All requirements must be met by date of appointment
- Be at least 21 years of age and no older than 35 years of age
- Be a citizen of the United States
- Be a resident of New Jersey and have a valid NJ driver's license
- Must have earned an Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university OR
- Have earned 60 credits from an accredited college or university AND have 2 years of active duty military service with an honorable discharge OR
- Have earned an associate's degree or 60 credits from an accredited college or university AND have 2 years' experience as a full time regular police officer OR
- Have earned an associate's degree or 60 college credits from an accredited college or university AND have a minimum of 24 months of satisfactory employment as a Class II Special Police Officer.
- Be of sound moral character verified by a background investigation

Testing procedures:

- Phase 1 Physical fitness indicator test
 - Sunday January 28, 2024 8:00 am
 - Southern Regional High School 11/12 gymnasium 105 Cedar Bridge Rd, Manahawkin, NJ 08050
 - IMPORTANT: Visit: https://www.staffordnj.gov/643/Police-Entrance-Test-Information to view an informational video about how to maximize your scores on the physical fitness indicator test.
 - **REMINDER**: A <u>mouthpiece</u> is required to take the boxing portion of the physical fitness indicator test.
 - Minimum passing score = 300
- Phase 2 Written exam
 - **Wed**nesday January 31, 2024 at 6:00 pm

- o **Phase 3 Initial interview** (scheduled upon passing physical and written portions)
- Phase 4 Background investigation (scheduled upon passing initial interview)
- Phase 5 Oral interview (scheduled upon passing background)
- **Phase 6 Medical clearance** (scheduled as a condition of employment)
 - Psychological screening
 - Medical screening
 - Drug screening
